Auto-complete Search Feature New!



Added to the Quicklaw Home page, the optional auto-complete search enhancement presents researchers with a drop-down list of suggested terms when search queries are entered into select boxes in the Find a Document search box. A list of matches is generated as the search query is typed, with the list progressively narrowing as the term is completed. Researchers can select a term from the drop-down list rather than completing the search query. This valuable new search tool helps Quicklaw researchers save time, consider additional search terms and ensure accuracy in their queries.

Sort by Citing Frequency Option New!

This new sort option in the results list gives researchers the ability to sort full-text cases from Canadian courts and tribunals according to the number of times these cases have been cited by other cases. With this feature, researchers have one more tool to focus quickly on the most pertinent and important cases.

Add Topic(s) to Search Functionality Now Enhanced [New!]

The Add Topic(s) to Search functionality enables researchers to retrieve all Canadian content on Quicklaw sorted by area of law, under specific topics or legal terms. Researchers can also combine their own search terms with topics selected from the classification. Formerly "Refine Search by Area(s) of Law," this functionality has now been enhanced and is accessible on several search forms on Quicklaw through the Add Topic(s) to Search link.

The enhancements include:

- · A new structure, based on The Canada Digest classification system, including all public and federal areas of law, as well as private areas of law. The private areas of law are subdivided into two distinct sections: civil law and common law.
- Fully expanded criminal and family areas of law. All other areas of law will first comprise two levels and will progressively expand throughout the year, reaching up to six levels of granularity. The refine tool will thus go from 450 to more than 3,000 legal topics, including 50 areas of law.
- Additional search options, such as the ability to perform a search using the alphanumerical code attached to a classification topic and the option to search the classification using a section of the Civil Code of Québec or the Code of Civil Procedure to find a topic covered by that section

Topic(s) Added to Search Highlighted in Retrieved Documents

Researchers are able to see pertinent terms highlighted in their retrieved documents in topical searches. When users apply the Add Topic(s) to Search (formerly "Refine Search by Area(s) of Law") feature to their searches, the topical terms will be highlighted in addition to any of the user's search terms. This information is being surfaced to indicate why each document is being retrieved in a topical search and to indicate why documents are being ranked in the order they appear in the results list.

Duplicate Options on News Power Search Form

Duplicate Options on the News Power Search form lets you choose whether or not you want to use similarity analysis to process your search results. Similarity analysis analyzes a results list, identifies documents that have similar content and groups the similar documents together.

Choose the type of similarity analysis you want from the Duplicate Options drop-down list:

- Off No similarity analysis. If similarity analysis has already been performed, the results list is regenerated without similarity analysis.
- On High similarity Documents must be nearly identical in order for the service to include them in the same group of similar documents.
- On Moderate similarity Documents with relatively less similarity can be included in the same group of similar documents.

Note: You can turn on Duplicate Options from the search form, or you can run your search, generate a results list, and then turn on Duplicate Options.

Similarity analysis may find that a results list contains one or more groups of similar documents (no document will be included in more than one group). Likewise, if no documents in the list are similar enough that they can be grouped together, the results list may contain no groups.

After similarity analysis has identified and grouped similar documents, it chooses one document in each group as the "lead document." These selections are based on user preferences that you can set up. In the results list, a lead document icon next to its title designates it as a lead document. Aside from this, lead documents are no different from any other documents in the list.
