Quicklaw®

- ▶ In Quicklaw each high level content type has its own tab, accessible from the homepage.



- ▶ By clicking on the respective tab, users are taken to an advanced search template providing them with fields for the most common segments applicable to that high level content type.

- ▶ In Lexis Advance Quicklaw, all documents of the same type have a common structure, composed of the natural parts or divisions referred to as *segments*.

Users can restrict their search to a specific part or segment of a document, by (1) clicking on the Advanced Search link in the top right corner of the page or by (2) using the Big Red Search Box at the top of your page.

Advanced Search Forms

Advanced Search Forms enable users to construct a more focused and precise search. This feature will assist users by making precision segment search capabilities more intuitive and easier to access.

Advanced Search Forms are accessible from the "Advanced Search" link at the top right corner of the red search box.

With the help of the segment examples at the bottom right of the page, users can better understand what portion of the document each field in the advanced search form is targeting.

► Big Red Search Box

Users can also restrict their search to a specific part of a segment in the Big Red Search Box.

Search can be performed based on the “Counsel”, which is applicable to Cases, Summaries or Quantums in which a particular lawyer or firm appeared as a counsel for one of the parties.

In addition to “Counsel” users can also search based on these other segments listed below.


- Judge: Applicable to Cases, Summaries or Quantums in which a particular Judge, Panel or Arbitrator presided over a case.
- Court: Applicable to Cases, Summaries or Quantums from a particular level of court or tribunal.
- Official-Title: Applicable to Official Titles of Statutes, Regulations, Codes and Rules.

In the Big Red Search Box, users can enter their search, beginning with the segment name, and followed by your search terms in parentheses.



- From the results list, users will only see results from the content types, and documents, that match the segment information typed in.




- Going into a document, users will be able to navigate to where search terms appear in the document by using the navigation arrows at the top of the page. Search terms will also be highlighted in yellow.



- Segment searches can be run as either a natural language or a Boolean search, depending on the search syntax you use.

The new search mechanism allows users to combine searches of multiple segments, such as "Judge" and "Counsel".

Segment Searching can also be completed post-search by simply entering the search term and once on the results page, applying the respective post filter that matches the content type.




- The Practice Area Pages are available directly from the home page.



- Once users are in a Practice Area Page, a customizable bookshelf hosts the practice area specific content.




- A user can also use the Source Directory to see a list of sources relevant to a particular practice area.





- Lexis Advance Quicklaw removes the need for Practice Area Pages by providing a comprehensive set of filters which can be used to specify a topic area.




- By selecting preferred legal topics, search results will be narrowed down to specific practice area.

Any topic or search can be saved for further use as a favourite or refined using the Research Map and available post-filters. In addition, Lexis Advance Quicklaw provides "Browse" functionality, where users can search for specific topics or browse through legal topics hierarchy from the main page.




- Quicklaw provides the user with a preset selection of Group Sources that enable the user to search all individual volumes, titles, or sub sources within it at once. These Group Sources can be accessed from the respective tab relevant to that Source.




- Quicklaw also provides the user the ability to create their own group source, and save these as Favourites.


- Lexis Advance Quicklaw has launched Explore Content pod to enable users to limit the search to a group of sources.



- Currently, users can narrow down their search into “Court Decisions”, “Case Summaries”, “Tribunal Decisions”, “Halsbury’s Law of Canada”, “JurisClasseur Quebec”, and “Carlson Personal Injury”.


Explore Content will be enhanced by other group sources such as News & Business in future. A user can do this with any number of sources, and then click on the “star” to save this as a Favourite.

- For some collections, Lexis Advance Quicklaw has grouped the content together as a popular source and provided a lot of sources for easier selection. By selecting the popular sources, users will be directed to a list of sources.





- Quicklaw enables the user to transition from a section of an Act, to view either a specific part of the Act, or the Act in its entirety – by using the “View More” box on the right hand side of the page



- Lexis Advance Quicklaw allows users to quickly navigate through an Act in one of two ways. Either use the Table of Contents to quickly navigate to a specific section within the Act

- For case results lists you have the option to have duplicate cases (the same case in a different reporter and/or language) be grouped as shadow documents behind one lead document, so that duplicates don't appear as separate documents in your results.





- ▶ From "My Bookshelf" there is a link to "Add/remove/sort sources". - ▶ From either the results page, or from a document, select the checkbox to the left of the document, and select the “Add to Folder” option above the results view, or the “Add to folder” option on the right of the case name in document view. In order to access the folder, click the “view folder” link at the top of the page. A maximum of 100 documents can be placed into the folder.




- ▶ From the results list, select the checkboxes next to the documents you wish to add. Select the Add to folder icon at the top of the results list. A list of folders appears. If you see the folder in which you want to store the list, simply select it. If you do not see the folder you want, select Choose a folder. The Add to Folder dialogue box appears.



- ▶ While viewing the document, select the Add to folder icon icon at the top of the document. If you see the folder in which you want to save the document, simply select it. If you do not see the folder you want, select Choose a folder. The Add to Folder dialogue box appears.



- ▶ Multiple folders can be created by the user. Folders can be accessed by selecting “More” dropdown on the top right hand side of the page, and choosing “Folders”



- Recent Searches: Click the History & Alerts tab. Click the History subtab, then click the Recent Searches subtab. A list of your recent searches appears. Each search you have run over the past 30 days is listed (up to a limit of 100 searches).




- Recent Documents: Click the History & Alerts tab. Click the History subtab, then click the Recent Documents subtab and a list of your documents is displayed. Each document you have viewed over the past 30 days is listed (up to a limit of 100 documents).

- You can view a list of your last 5 searches and a list of the last 5 documents you have opened in the History pod on the home page or by selecting the **History** button at the top of any page. You can view the entire history list by selecting **View all history** at the bottom of the History Pod or by selecting the **History** button and by selecting **View all history** at the bottom of the list that appears.

You can also access a “Research Map” for a more visual representation of your history steps. 


- When viewing a document after searching, the total number of hits for all your terms will appear in the bottom right hand side of your screen. Click on the back and forward arrows in order to jump to each term, or to the first or last hit.

- ▶ Carlson Personal Injury Quantum of Damages can be accessed in Quicklaw clicking the court cases tab at the top of the page. From the next page, choose “Carlson Personal Injury” on the left hand side.




- ▶ From the next screen the user has the ability to either Search Carlson using a search form template, or Browse Carlson using a Table of Contents.

Searching allows the user the ability to enter various pieces of information such as Quantum of Damages, Injury Type, Injury Cause and Physician in order to search for cases that match those criteria.

- ▶ Browsing allows the user to ability to view a Table of Contents index for specific categories in Carlson, and find cases that match a specific Injury type, or injury cause for example.

- ▶ Carlson Personal Injury Quantum of Damages can be accessed in Lexis Advance Quicklaw through “Explore Content Pod” or “Browse”.



- ▶ Clicking on “Carlson Personal Injury” link in Explore Content Pod, users are able to filter their search by Quantum Damages, Type of Injury, Cause of Injury, and jurisdiction for example.

- ▶ Carlson can also be accessed by browsing the sources through Sources > Canada > Category > Quantum from the top left hand side of the page. From the results list users can click on Carlson Personal Injury of Quantum Digests dropdown, and choose to “Get Documents” from this source, add the source as a pre filter, or access the Quantum as a table of contents index below the drop down.

- ▶ Wrongful Dismissal Notice Searcher can be accessed in Quicklaw by clicking the Court Cases tab at the top of the page. On the next page choose “Wrongful Dismissal Notice Searcher” from the left hand side of the page.

- ▶ From the next screen the user has the ability to either Search the Wrongful Dismissal Notice Searcher using a search form template.

Searching allows the user the ability to enter various pieces of information such as Job Category, Position, Years Employed, and Age of Employee in order to search for cases that match those criteria.

Lexis Advance® Quicklaw®

- ▶ Wrongful Dismissal Notice Searcher can be accessed in Lexis Advance Quicklaw by searching or browsing. A user can type in “Wrongful Dismissal Notice Searcher” into the Big Red Search Box. From the list of suggestion in the Word Wheel, the user can select the “Wrongful Dismissal Notice Searcher” option and choose to “Get Documents” from this source.

- ▶ Clicking on “Get Documents” from this source takes users to a results page which provides them with all cases in the Wrongful Dismissal Notice Searcher. From here users can choose to filter further by selecting the Wrongful Dismissal Notice Searcher option under the “Quantum Type” post filter on the right of the page.

- ▶ The Post Filters will open up specific Wrongful Dismissal Notice Searcher filters on the right hand side of the page enabling users to post filter by Age of Employee, Job Category, and Years Employed for example.

- ▶ The Wrongful Dismissal Notice Searcher can also be accessed by browsing the sources through Sources > Canada > Category > Quantum from the top left hand side of the page. From the results list users can click on Wrongful Dismissal Notice Searcher dropdown, and choose to “Get Documents” from this source, or add the source as a pre filter.

- Next, select “Sources” from the left hand side of the page, and choose Halsbury's Laws of England to filter by this source.
