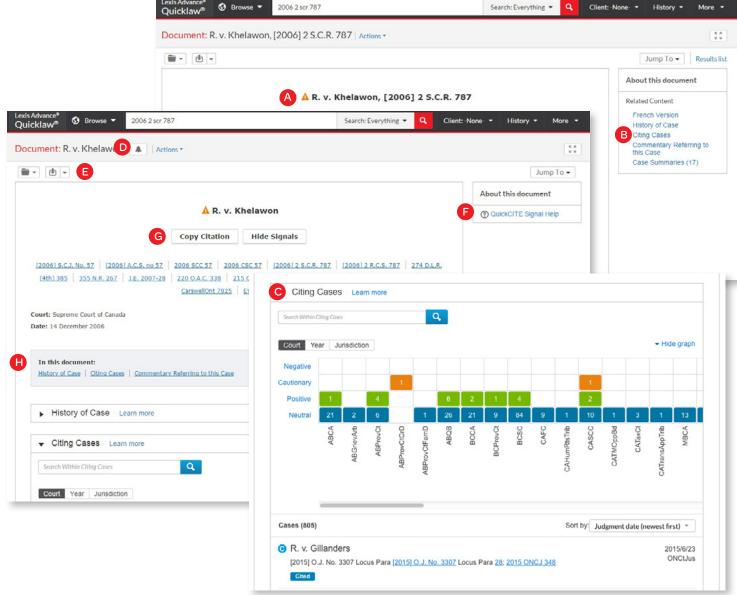
Note up with QuickCITE



- A See treatment indicators up front. QuickCITE signal indicators show subsequent treatment at a glance.
- B Navigate quickly to the QuickCITE report section that generated the signal:
 - History of Case
 - Citing Cases
 - Commentary Referring to this Case
- Get the big picture on Citing Cases. Under Citing Cases, you can access and review a graphical representation of citing cases in context by Treatment, Court, Year and Jurisdiction.

- D The alert is triggered by a major change that will impact the signal.
- E Familiar icons let you print, download, email or save reports to a Folder, or deliver report specifics. For example, you can hide signals, history of case, citing cases or commentary.
- F Review what each signal indicator means by clicking on the link to QuickCITE signal help.
- **G** Copy the full-case citation for your work, including parallel citations and a link to the full-text case.
- $oxed{\mathbb{H}}$ Navigate quickly to the different parts of the QuickCITE record.
