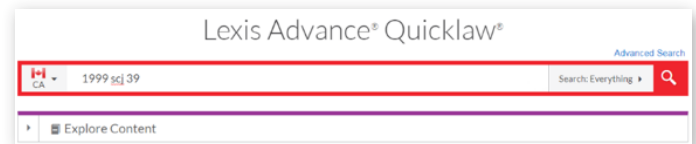


RESEARCHING THE CASE OR STATUTE YOU'VE BEEN GIVEN

Read a case once and understand it. Lexis Advance Quicklaw® has built-in tools that make case law easier to understand. These tools will help you digest and analyze a large volume of information efficiently.

START BY PULLING UP A CASE ON LEXIS ADVANCE QUICKLAW®.

Enter the citation for your case in the Red Search Box. This will retrieve the document.



TOP THREE TOOLS FOR UNDERSTANDING YOUR CASE AND FINDING RELATED AUTHORITY:

1. Get your bearings with a Case Summary.

It's like a mini case brief. Read this first for a clear overview of the facts and holdings of the case.

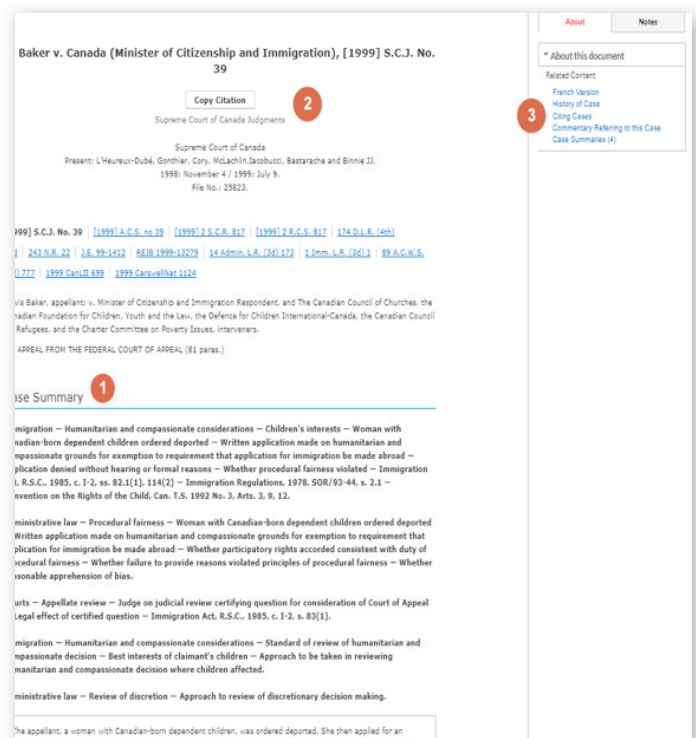
Now you'll only need to read the case once to understand it, saving hours of time.

2. Save time with Copy Citation

The Copy Citation button allows you to quickly copy the citation for the case with or without all of the parallel citations. You can even create a hyperlink to link back to the document on Lexis Advance Quicklaw.

3. Quickly access essential Related Content.

Use the About section to quickly determine the History of the Case, learn which cases have referred to this case using 'Citing Cases' and review Commentary or alternative Case Summaries.

1. Check the Table of Contents

Access other Sections, or view the full Statute source table of contents.

2. View cases referring to the Section

QuickCite for legislation will show you the cases that have cited your statute. Seeing how those past cases construed your statute will provide you with evidence of how the statute would likely be applied.

3. Access Point in Time Legislation from 'About this Document'

See the Section as it used to be – and as it may have been when referred to in a case – for Ontario, Alberta, British Columbia and Federal Statutes. You can also access Regulations under the Act.

4. Check the currency of the statute

Current Version information is listed at the top of the document.
