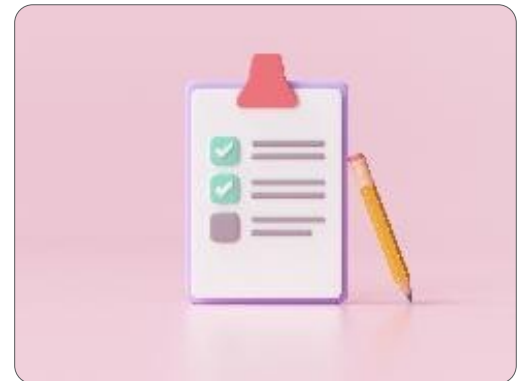
Capital Markets and M&A

- ▶ As of July 2025, new protections exist for **digital platform workers** (also known as “gig workers”) in Ontario. workers, including who is considered a digital platform worker, what their entitlements are, and relevant considerations for operations of digital platforms.
