5 tips to help with your legal resume

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Make an appointment with your Career Services office and go over your resume with them! They will help you greatly and have insight into what different law firms are looking for.

Make sure to re-read your resume multiple times! Check for any spelling or grammatical errors, and make sure your verb tense stays the same.

Try to make it concise and not too lengthy. Show your legal experience and delete any irrelevant experience or any experience that goes too far back, such as volunteering commitments in high school.
